FAQ - Psychologists in other Canadian provinces

Q. I am a psychologist in another Canadian province and would like to provide remote service to a person who is in Québec at the time of receiving the service.

A. A psychologist located outside Québec may provide remote service to clients in Québec. They do not need a Québec permit to do so. We recommend, however, that a person located outside Québec who provides online services to a client in Québec be legally authorized to practice psychology in their home jurisdiction and carry professional liability insurance. It is also recommended that clients be advised that any complaints or disciplinary proceedings would have to be brought before the regulatory body in the jurisdiction where the psychologist is located.

Q. I am a psychologist in another Canadian province and I will be in Québec for several months. I would like to continue seeing my clients in my home province remotely.

A. When a psychologist from another Canadian province (or any other jurisdiction in the world) is in Québec temporarily and wishes to continue serving their clients in their home jurisdiction remotely, they need a permit or special authorization issued by the *Ordre des psychologues du Québec* to do so.
